


Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Self-control and (2) Self-efficacy







Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Legal Cynicism and (2) Exposure to extremist peers



Discussion


- The effects of COVID-19 conspiracy beliefs on support for anti-government violence are much stronger for individuals who show higher levels of narcissism, Machiavellianism and sadism
- No moderating effects were found for psychopathy
- The risk effects of COVID-19 conspiracy beliefs beliefs on support for anti-government violence are dampened among those with high levels of altruism and honesty-humility









Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Social Exclusion and (2) External Locus of Control




Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Social Exclusion and (2) External Locus of Control







Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Vengeance and (2) Psychopathy




Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Vengeance and (2) Psychopathy










Interaction between Conspiracy Mentality and (1) Prosociality and (2) Social Support

Discussion

Conditional relationship between CM and risk as well as protective factors – relevance and functional role on VE

More research into protective factors for CM and VE – conditional effects of risk as well as buffering protective factors

P/CVE program should strengthen protective factors – increase resilience towards conspiratorial as well as extremist beliefs

More research into developmental trajectories underpinning VE and conspiracy mentality



Vulnerability Profiles and Developmental Trajectories



'Semi' longitudinal approach whereby we measure the developmental trajectories of shared risk factors to determine vulnerability profiles over time



'Latent Growth Mixture Modelling' for multivariate markers to determine latent classes of individuals with similar growth trajectories



Relate the different developmental vulnerability profiles to violent extremist attitudes and conspiracy mentality at wave 9


