Janet Currie is the Henry Putnam Professor of Economics and Public Affairs at Princeton University, the chair of Princeton's Economics Department, and the co-director of Princeton's Center for Health and Wellbeing.

Her research focuses on health and wellbeing, especially of children. In more than 130 publications, she advanced the field of child development, establishing the role of early life intervention programs, programs to expand health insurance and improve health care, public housing, and food and nutrition programs.

On Saturday, April 29, 2017, Janet Currie will be awarded an **Honory Doctorate** from the University of Zurich as part of the University's *Dies academicus* festivities.
